OUR WHY

In 2014, *Then Sings My Soul*[™] (TSMS) was inspired by an unscripted unrehearsed conversation with a circle of my close singing sister friends. The women were at dinner and began talking and sharing stories, personal viewpoints on domestic violence among women. Out of this heartfelt, sincere gathering came a vision from God to create a stage play, that lead to in-person programming and awareness events, that has now brought us to adapting the screenplay for a full-length feature film...and it all started from a stage play in DC at THEARC Theater.

THE STAGE PLAY

Wyomme created and successfully ran the 6year stage play *Then Sings My Soul*[™]. Wyomme would continue on to win **Sisters4Sisters Network, Inc. (S4SN) Woman of The Month Award** from the Domestic Violence Committee and the **UnStoppable You Speakers Award** for her work sharing domestic violence awareness through the arts. Recently, Wyomme was honored with the **2022 Community Stars Award** by Sisters4Sisters Network, Inc.

THE FILM

From the stage to big screen, the vision and the movement continue through film! Wyomme Pariss is beginning pre-production on, *Then Sings My Soul*[™], the film. This is sure to be an inspiring story, telling the lives of seven women who overcome their struggles and unite their voices in <u>victory</u> against domestic violence! A much-needed story to be told, *Then Sings My Soul*[™], the Film is projected to debut in 2023.

THE MOVEMENT

As a result of the positive reviews and community outcry for more awareness, Wyomme created the **Then Sings My Soul (TSMS) Youth Performing Arts and Education (YPAE) Program**, an innovative, comprehensive community based program that provides a positive impact on youth by teaching in the area of dance, drama, vocals, recording sessions, and audition preparation. To date, *Then Sings My Soul*[™], the Movement, now encompassing an admin team, survivor interviews, awareness videos and more, provides an outlet for reaching hundreds and thousands of people by awareness through the arts.



OUR STORY

Then Sings My Soul[™] brings the audience face-to-face with women and men who are in the fight of their lives around domestic violence. Their various trials and situations threaten to rob them of their freedom, their joy, and, ultimately, their souls. Once they come to understand that we all must play our part to put an end to the cycle of violence, their individual (and collective) healing can begin and their souls begin to sing.

Characters

The Counselor: holds group counseling with all of the women; unites the group in understanding and comes to her own enlightenment along the way

Tanya: bright, college-bound high school senior, her future plans are on hold as she stands on trial for the murder of her abusive step-father

Grandmother: elderly woman raising the young child of her only daughter, currently in a coma after a traumatic attempted murder by her abusive boyfriend, due to jealousy of her sexuality

Attorney: takes on a few of the women's cases and connects with the friend group overall, unveiling her own enlightenment and frustration dealing with the injustices of the judicial system

Diva: thriving and touring recording artist, contracts an STD from her fiancé, pausing her career, to start her personal healing journey

Evelyn: devoted wife to the closeted bi-sexual pastor of a mega church; suffers miscarriages and domestic violence by her husband's hand, fueled by his shame and pastoral pride

Sheila: mother of two and wife of Officer Tony; succumbs one night to the rage of husband's drunken binge and loses her life to domestic violence

Officer Tony: Sheila's husband and responding officer in Tanya's case; manipulates his power and influence as a police officer to cover up his tracks with Tanya and Sheila

In the final act of the stage play, the ladies rejoin in group therapy sharing their stories: Sheila's death shakes the group; the women rally around one another as Grandma's daughter awakens from the coma; the First Lady leaves her pastor husband, while Diva seeks treatment for her disease and moves forward confidently in life; Tanya receives a non-guilty verdict, throwing the group into celebration and hope. The group, celebrating their outcomes, begins dancing and singing an original composition, *"Then Sings My Soul." We* close with all hands triumphantly in the air, an act of praise, exaltation and victory.


